Notice of Regatta

1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Lake Pontchartrain Racing Circuit (LPRC) Bylaws, and as amended by the LPRC 2025 Sailing Instructions.

2. Ratings

LPRC will use the EZ Rule (formerly ORR-Ez) ratings for all classes and courses.

3. Eligibility and Entry

All Classes: Boats must have a valid 2025 EZ certificate no later than the Skipper's Meeting. The valid certificates and your certificate number can be found at https://regattaman.com/certificate_page.php. Boats shall only declare one valid EZ certificate for the regatta which cannot be changed after the conclusion of the Skipper's Meeting.

4. Divisions

There shall be three divisions: Spinnaker, Racer/Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker. Four boats are required to constitute a division. Divisions may be further separated into classes based upon participation. Boats of similar size and performance may be grouped together in a class.

If 5 or more boats of a single design register before September 26, they may be split into their own class under their respective division.

- 4.1 Spinnaker, Racer/Cruiser, Non-Spinnaker
Boats must be single hulled.

- 4.2 Racer/Cruiser Division
Stored power for winches is allowed for this division - this changes RRS 52.

- 4.3 Non-Spinnaker Division
Spinnakers are not allowed in this division.
Jibs are the only headsails allowed in this division.
The largest jib is specified on the rating certificate.
Only one jib may be carried at any time except when changing jibs.
Whisker poles must be affixed to the mast, see RRS 55.2.
Stored power for winches is allowed for this division - this changes RRS 52.

5. Fees and Registration

- 5.1 Early Bird Special Registration fee of \$75 is available through September 5, 2025.
- 5.2 Online registration: <http://www.nextsailor.com/regatta/lprc2025>
- 5.3 Entry fees: \$100 on or before September 26th, \$125 after September 27th. Late entries may be accepted until 30 minutes before the Skipper's Meeting on October 23 at New Orleans Yacht Club.

6. Schedule

Skippers Meeting - Thursday Oct. 23, 2025 at 1900 at New Orleans Yacht Club.

Four to five races are scheduled for Spinnaker division. Three races are scheduled for Racer/Cruiser and Non-Spinnaker divisions, with the possibility of two more at the discretion of the Race Committee. There shall be no make-up races. There will be no warning signal after 1400 hours on the last day of racing.

7. Venue

Lake Pontchartrain, Louisiana – (NOAA Chart 11369).

8. Courses

- 8.1 Spinnaker division, two to four custom course races and one distance race.
- 8.2 Racer/Cruiser and Non-Spinnaker divisions, a minimum of two custom course races and one distance race. A second custom course race may be sailed on Friday and Sunday, time and weather permitting, at the discretion of the Race Committee.

9. Penalty System

US Sailing Appendix V, "Alternative Penalties" shall apply - this changes RRS 44.1.

10. Scoring

- 10.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply, except that no race scores will be excluded. This changes RRS A2.1. One race will constitute a series.
- 10.2 Corrected times for all classes will be calculated using EZ Performance Curve Scoring (PCS).

11. Awards

- 11.1 First, second, and third place awards will be given in each class with five or more boats on the starting line for the regatta. First place awards will be given if a class has less than five boats.

- 11.2 First place awards will be given for individual races on Friday and Sunday. First, second, and third place awards will be given for the distance race on Saturday. Daily trophies and "Boat of the Day" prizes will be awarded at the end of each day's racing and is scheduled for approximately 90 minutes after the Committee boat docks.
- 11.3 Best Spinnaker Boat of the Regatta Award, the Stewart R. "Tootie" Barnett Trophy, and the "Red Jacket Award," will be awarded on the last day of the regatta. The Committee may award the Non-Spinnaker perpetual trophy and blue jacket to the Best Non-Spinnaker Boat of the Regatta if 8 or more boats register and sail in that division. Best Racer/Cruiser Boat of the Regatta will be awarded a perpetual trophy for that. In the event that all classes in a division do not finish a race due to time limits or a race is abandoned, that race will not count in determining the Boat of the Regatta for that division. Failure of one division to finish will not affect the other divisions. The Julian Richards Memorial trophy will be awarded to the overall series winner of Spinnaker Class A as determined by the series results.
- 11.4 Additional trophies for best junior skipper, best female skipper, oldest skipper, best past participation in previous LPRCs may be awarded on the last day of the regatta.

12. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. Youth Sailing Programs

A portion of the proceeds of the LPRC Regatta may be used to assist youth sailing programs.

14. Safety

- 14.1 All boats shall carry all U.S.C.G. required safety equipment.
- 14.2 All boats shall carry a functional VHF radio.

15. Docking and Launching

- 15.1 Transient slips are available in the Municipal Yacht Harbor. See their web site, <https://nomyh.com> for a harbor map. Contact Brian Whited at brian.whited@nola.gov or (504) 283-9676 for more information and to make a reservation.
- 15.2 Orleans Levee District owns and operates the Orleans Marina near SYC and NOYC and South Shore Harbor Marina with transient slips, power, and water. Contact: 504-288-2351.
- 15.3 Tammany Yacht Club
 - 15.3.1 Oak Harbor Marina may have available slips. Contact information can be found at <https://www.oakharbormarina-slidell.com/>
 - 15.3.2 TYC has one hoist available for small craft wishing to launch from their trailer.
 - 15.3.3 TYC has space on the club dock with no power or water. Please contact the club for details.
