Entries:	Participants are required to register on Next Sailor by Friday, October 1, 2021. Next Sailor: https://www.nextsailor.com/regatta/179

Eligible classes:	This regatta is open to all boats in the following: Handicap Division: CHESSS, CRCA, Multihull & PHRF. Classes in each division will be based on participation. Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid 2021 handicap certificate. One design: Any CBYRA Sanctioned One-Design with at least 3 boats entered.
Rendezvous:	At 1040 at Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark"T" Baltimore Light. There will be a mandatory check in.
Signals:	First signal at 1055 hrs. See event Sailing Instructions for further details.
Radio:	Boats should monitor VHF 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Some class starts may be combined based on number of entries.
Rules:	The race shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021–2024. The Event Sailing Instructions will be emailed to each participant no later than Thursday, Sept 30, 2021 and posted on the Official Notice Board, located electronically at https://www.nextsailor.com/regatta/179
Safety:	All entries shall adhere to US Sailing Equipment Requirements (SER), Revision 2021.0 for Nearshore. A copy of Nearshore requirements is available at http://eastportyc.org/racing , located under "Racing Resources." A yacht abandoning the race shall report to the Race Committee via VHF Channel 72.
Start:	Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" Baltimore Light.
Course:	To be displayed by the RC at the time of the race, using marks listed in the 2021 GSI as Region 2, Chesapeake Bay Area Standard Racing Marks. A course for the slower fleets will be posted first, BREAK – then longer course posted for remaining classes. The RC plans to offer two courses depending on wind speed and direction. Course notice will be provided 24 hours prior to event start or earlier if possible, via email to all registrants. Duration of the race is expected to be roughly 5 hrs.
Finish:	Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and "W" GC1 south of Rock Hall channel.
Time limit:	None: A yacht finishing after the Race Committee has left station must take her own time and report to the Race Committee via VHF 72.
Scoring:	PHRF handicap scoring will be in accordance with the Time-On-Time Circular Random rating.
Protests:	Verbally notify Race Committee boat of protest prior to leaving finish area. Mail protest forms, postmarked by Tuesday 05 October 2021, to James Bradac, 10739 Easterday Rd, Myersville, MD 21773. Parties involved in protests will be notified of date and time of hearing, to be held at PSA Clubhouse, 283 Cove Road off Lake Shore Drive and Ferry Point Road, Pasadena, MD.
Social:	Conduct of any post-race social activities will depend on the situation surrounding COVID at the time of the race. An announcement concerning the post-race plans will be made in the weeks

before the race.

If conditions warrant, participants are invited to the shore party and happy hour hosted at Haven Harbor marina in beautiful Swan Creek.
