

## **Notice to Competitors - Special Marine Warnings**

This weekend's forecast is complicated and there is a possibility of some unpleasant or potentially dangerous conditions.

We will monitor radar data closely and also keep NOAA weather radio on.

IF NOAA issues a **Special Marine Warning\***, all racing will be abandoned. Competitors will be notified over VHF 72 to seek safe harbor or anchor safely out of the channel and in the lee of shore, should safe harbor be unobtainable.

The Signal boat will also sound three short horns and hoist race signal NOVEMBER over ALPHA, signifying ALL RACING IS *abandoned*. No more racing today.



\*Special Marine Warning: A severe local storm warning affecting coastal water areas, or a warning of potentially hazardous weather conditions usually of short duration (2 hours or less) and producing wind speeds of 34 KT or more that is not adequately covered by existing marine warnings. Also, this product is issued for waterspouts, either predicted or occurring.
