You probably noticed the class “MID ATLANTIC DESTINATION RACERS - NAAR Ratings” on the Current Entries page.

This is just an analytical tool we’ll use to:

- 1) examine how each boat, no matter which scoring method (PHRF, ORR-Ez, or One Design) did against every other boat that raced. (Made possible because everyone sailed the same course)
- 2) We are considering offering a BEST OVERALL award and possibly even offer a perpetual trophy in the future, depending on the success of this tool. For a local reference, an OVERALL trophy was offered at the SMCM Governor’s Cup this past August and was a big hit, using the same scoring analytics.

So no matter which class you race in on Saturday, we’ll be able to score you OVERALL and even share with you which scoring program gave you the best score.

This scoring analysis is being used currently by St. Michaels Wednesday Night Racing to score this year’s races.
