website by 2200 the day preceding the event. RRS 90.2 (c) is in effect: Oral changes to

the SI's may occur on the water prior to the Warning Signal.

Radio: Boats shall monitor VHF 72 for communications from the Race Committee, including on

water changes to the SI's.

Rendezvous: At 1030 in the vicinity of CBYRA Mark "FF"

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and CBYRA Mark "FF" or nearby

government mark, or as amended in posted addendum.

Signals: RRS26 (Starting times) will be announced by 22:00 October 18, 2025

Course/Rules: Designated by letters displayed on Race Committee boat, as further described in the CBYRA

Green Book General Sailing Instructions and NORTH CHESAPEAKE BAY BRIDGE AREA and BALTIMORE HARBOR & PATAPSCO RIVER AREA, with additional RCRA Yellow

Marks as follows.

RCRA "A" N39° 10.902, W076 29.291' RCRA "B" N39° 10.117, W076 29.706' RCRA "C" N39° 10.500, W076 28.500'

Rule 32.2 is modified as follows: Each boat shall pass sufficiently close to each course mark

to ascertain whether the course has been shortened at any of the course marks.

GSI Rule 17.1 is modified as follows: For penalties while racing, RRS 44.1, One-Turn

Penalties ONLY will apply.

Finish: GSI Rule 16.2 is modified: The finishing line will be between the staff or halyard containing

an ORANGE flag on a race committee vessel and the course side of the designated finish mark. Course may be shortened at any designated course mark. Boats not finishing are

requested to notify Race Committee boat on VHF Channel 72.

Time Limit: 4 hours.

Scoring: Assignment to a specific class division will be based on participation and is not grounds for

redress

PHRF - Scoring, class rules and boat ratings as per PHRF of the Chesapeake Class Rules. Random Leg rating, Time-on-Distance. PHRF CCNS fleet shall be limited to one headsail

flown at a time except for cutter rigs as noted.

CRCA – Scoring and ratings will be in conformance with class rules, Time-on-Time. Entrants using ORR-Ez ratings shall comply with the ORR-Ez Rulebook and CRCA Class Rules. CRCA class sail configuration, Spin vs Non-Spin, shall be made by Friday October

17 23:59.

Multihull – Scoring, class rules and boat ratings as per The Chesapeake Multi-Hull

Association, Time-on-Time.

Protests: Protester should immediately notify Race Committee boat upon finishing. Written protest

forms must be postmarked by Tuesday 21 October 2025 to the contact listed above.

Protester and protested will be notified of the time and place of the protest hearing.

Safety: Safety Equipment Requirements: US Sailing Monohull SER Nearshore is in effect for this
