FWYC encourages competitors to monitor the Regatta website for current Regatta information.

- 1. Rules: The Regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2. Eligibility and Entry: The Jubilee Regatta is open to boats and competitors meeting the eligibility requirements as described in the (TCA) rules. (All Skippers must be dues paid TCA members; all boats must be Registered Thistles). Eligible participants must register in advance for the Regatta by completing the on-line registration at the link below.
- **3. Registration:** To register for the regatta, visit <u>www.nextsailor.com</u>.
- **4. Fees:** The Entry fee is \$30.00 or \$25.00 for members of US Sailing. There are no scheduled social events.
- 5. Schedule: (Central Time Zone)

Saturday (November 7)

0930 No onsite registration. All boats must be registered online before this time.

1130 Virtual Skipper's Meeting (VHF Channel 72)

1300 Warning Signal for Race 1. Multiple races will be held.

Sunday (November 8)

0930 Warning Signal for remaining races. No race to start after 1230 CT.

- **6. VHF Radios:** The Race Committee may use VHF radios to inform competitors of safety information and to hail boats that are on-course side of the starting line (OCS) at the start and general information to assist in the management of the event. No transmissions will be allowed by any competitor while on the water.
- **7. Sailing Instructions:** The Sailing Instructions will be available online at www.nextsailor.com... These Sailing Instructions may be modified or amended.
- **8. Scoring:** A total of 5 races are scheduled and all races sailed will be scored. Boats will be scored in accordance with Appendix A of the RRS as modified by the following statements. One race completed constitutes a regatta.
- **9. Prizes:** Trophies will be awarded to the highest placing Thistles. Trophies will be available for pickup in the FWYC Office. No awards ceremony will be conducted.
- **10. Insurance and Damages:** A. The Organizing Committee does not assume any responsibility of any sort regarding the participants and boats. Competitors should have their own insurance covering all risks.
- **11. COVID-19 Policy:** All participants (skipper and crew) are required to sign and return the FWYC Event Waiver before the first race of the Regatta. Failure to do so will result in being disqualified from the Regatta.
