Eligible: This Regatta is open to all sailboats in the following:
Handicap Division: CHESSS, CRCA, Multihull, ORC, & PHRF.
Classes in each division will be based on participation.
Participants competing in a handicap class shall have a valid
2025 handicap certificate.
One Design classes: Any CBYRA Sanctioned One Design with at least 3 boats entered.

Rendezvous: At 1040 hrs at Region 2 Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T"

Baltimore Light. There will be a Mandatory check in with the

Committee Boat. Boats are allowed to check in with VHF channel
72.

Signals: First signal at 1055 hrs. See Event Sailing Instructions for further details.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF channel 72 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee. Some class starts may be combined based on the number of entries.

Rules:The Race shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2025-2028. The Event Sailing Instructions will be emailed to each participant no later than 1900 hrs Thursday October 2 and posted on the Official Notice Board located on Next Sailor under the PSA Race to MYC.

Safety: All entries shall adhere to US Sailing Equipment Requirements (SER), Revision 2021.0 for Nearshore. A copy of Nearshore Requirements is available at <a href="http://eastportyc.org/racing">http://eastportyc.org/racing</a>. Located under Racing Resources. A yacht abandoning the race shall report to the Race Committee via VHF channel 72.

Start: Between orange flag on RC boat and Mark "T" Baltimore Light.

Course: To be displayed by the RC boat at the time of the race, using marks listed in the 2025 GSI North of the Bay Bridge including Baltimore Harbor and Patapsco River Area 2024 Standard Racing marks. See:

Finish: Will be displayed by the RC boat at the time of race. Most likely in the Patapsco River.

- Time Limit: None. A yacht finishing after the Race Committee has left station must take her own time and report to the Race Committee via VHF channel 72 or phone 410-375-5994.
- Scoring: PHRF handicap scoring will be in accordance with the Time on Time Circular Random Rating.
- Protests: Verbally notify Race Committee boat of protest prior to leaving the finish area. Email protest forms to Tim Ford by Tuesday October 7, 2025. Parties involved in protests will be notified of date and time of hearing, to be held at PSA Clubhouse, 283 Cove Road, Pasadena MD
- Social: There will be a Post Race Shore Party at the Pavillion at Maryland Yacht Club. All racers (owners and crew) will be treated to a signature cocktail, beer, wine and soft drinks, snacks and 6 raw oysters on the half shell. A special dinner buffet for \$25, including soft drinks, will be available at the Maryland Yacht Club clubhouse. Meals must be pre-purchased by October 1, 2025 on

mydc.org website under <u>Events</u>. Larry the Six String Sailor will be entertaining in the clubhouse. The bar will be open.

Slips at MYC: Slips are available for the Post Race Party and for overnight. Reserve your slip, with code SPECIALEVENTS2025 for a 75% discount, through Dockwa on the MYC <u>Transients</u> page. There is no charge for temporary day dockage. Mention you are doing the PSA Race to MYC in your reservation.
