NOTICE OF RACE 2025 BBSC Blue Nose Race Saturday, January 25th

1. RULES & SCORING

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. Prior to start, each boat will be:
 - 1.2.1. Safely anchored, engine OFF, sails DOWN, all crew below decks, hull numbers displayed (as required), current registration and/or documentation onboard. At the start signal the following will happen:
 - 1.2.1.1. Crew emerges from below-decks wearing PFDs.
 - 1.2.1.2. Start engines, or raise sails, or both, and break anchor.
 - 1.2.1.3. Proceed to the starting line and safely do the following:
 - 1.2.1.3.1. Boats with a wheel start the race using the emergency tiller.
 - 1.2.1.3.2. Display a Type IV PFD to the race committee.
 - 1.2.1.3.3. Display a serviceable fire extinguisher to the race committee.
 - 1.2.1.3.4. Demo the boat's sound producing device.
 - 1.2.1.3.5. Show that you have a valid and unexpired day signal (Distress Flag, Smoke, or Day/Night Flares).
 - 1.2.1.3.6. STYLE POINTS: Safely deploy (fire) an expired smoke or day/night flare.

NOTE: Lighting, or launching smoke or a flare is optional, but highly encouraged if you've never done it. Use gloves. Race committee has already coordinated with the USCG, Florida Fish & Wildlife, and local authorities to let them know about our safety exercise and expect an advisory call on channel 16 from the race committee prior to the race.

- 1.2.2. After starting, safely stow emergency gear as conditions permit.
- 1.3. Boats with a wheel will use the emergency tiller at some point during the race.
- 1.4. Every boat shall practice a man overboard drill during the race using a floating object (not a real person).

2. COMMUNICATION

2.1. This Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and notices to competitors will be available upon release electronically online at the official noticeboard at: https://nextsailor.com/regatta/2025BN (QR Code above) and also posted in hardcopy on the BBSC corkboard in LJ Schooner's Oyster Bar (in the bigscreen TV area).

3. ELIGIBIITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. The race is open to all boats. The Fleet Captain will assign you a rating if your boat does not have one.
- 3.2. Register for the race electronically at the link in 2.1 (above), or in-person prior to the competitor's meeting.



3.3. Fees: The entry fee is \$10 per boat for this race, or one-time \$200 for the 2025 season.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1. One Class, X-Class
 - 4.1.1. X-Class will use a back-calculated rating based on prior performance in BBSC events. Contact the Fleet Captain (info below) for details.

6.1. The race will be a random leg course on the waters of the Choctawhatchee Bay & connecting bayou(s).

7.1. RRS 3 States the following: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that each skipper is responsible for the safety of his/her vessel and crew.
